

2009 FORMULA 1™ Singapore Grand Prix Track Barrier System Installation

The Event

Singapore is provisionally scheduled to host its second Grand Prix on 27 September 2009. The event will be promoted by Singapore GP Pte Ltd (SGP). The race is to be conducted at night under lights and will be held on a modified street circuit around secured sections of inner Singapore, typically at the same time each year.

The Event is held over three days (Friday to Sunday inclusive), however there are a number of facilities which are required to be completed well prior to the Event. The race shall be supported by related on and off track activities to deliver a large scale major event within a ticketed boundary.

The time for installation, commissioning and removal of all temporary event infrastructure is limited with respect to minimising traffic and business disruption and occupancy of public and private space. During the construction and dismantling phase, works will generally be carried out in public places and contractors must plan suitably with respect to the protection of people and property

Summary of Works

The following is a guide to the scope of works required in undertaking the provision of Track Barrier System Installation required for the Singapore SingTel Formula One Grand Prix.

Scope of Works

The scope of works are summarised as follows:

Provision of works associated with the timely supply of labour and equipment to perform Track Barrier System Installation for the Singapore Grand Prix.

The scope of works required under the Contract shall include, but not be limited to:

- Preliminaries, including provision of own site facilities;
- Transportation, unpacking and repacking of SGP inventory from storage Yard in Tampines (as applicable);
- Supply transport, installation of various works at SGP F1 site including the following :
 - Installation and removal of pre-cast concrete barriers
 - Installation and removal of debris fence and pin system
 - Installation and removal of triple guardrail installations

- Provision of a standby crew during the event period for maintenance and rectification.
- Provision of all traffic management, including all approvals required for works undertaken on public roads.
