Enclosed is your ticket as well as some practical tips to maximise your enjoyment and make the most out of your race weekend.

Gear Up

Here are a few tried and tested tips:

- Singapore's climate is generally warm and humid all year, so be sure to wear comfortable clothing and put on sunblock if you plan to arrive early.
- Travel light for a speedy clearance during the security screening at the gates (see 'What Not To Bring').
- The Circuit Park has something for everyone, from a wide selection of food, beverage and merchandise outlets to exciting performances by local and international artistes and thrilling on-track action. Be sure to put on a good pair of walking shoes and explore the Circuit Park.

 Log on to www.singaporegp.sg for the full on-track and off-track line-up. Artiste line-up is subject to change. Visit the official website for artiste performance timings, zones and stages.

Operation Hours

The Circuit Park will open from:

- 2pm to 12 midnight Friday (15 Sep)
- 3pm to 12 midnight Saturday (16 Sep)
- 3pm to 12 midnight Sunday (17 Sep)

A general pass consists of a separate ticket and lanyard for each race day. Guests are required to display the ticket and lanyard of the corresponding day clearly at all times. Please note that upon entry to the Circuit Park, tickets are non-transferable for that particular day.

Should you decide to bring along additional guests, please note that ticketing booths are located next to selected gates around the Circuit Park over the race weekend (subject to availability of tickets).

What Not To Bring

For safety reasons, certain items are not permitted in the Circuit Park.

These include, but are not limited to,

- Any bulky items such as folding chairs, bicycles and scooters
- · Remote controlled crafts and drones
- Corporate, commercial and brand-specific flags
- Laser pointersPets
- Articles prohibited by Singapore law such as fireworks, flares and weapons
- Videographic or photographic equipment for professional use

Guests are not permitted to bring in their own food and beverages, except for one clear plastic bottle of soft drink or mineral water of not more than 600ml per person.

Please note that bag checks will be conducted at all gates.

Photography And Videography

By entering the Circuit Park, each guest is deemed to have agreed and accepted that all sound and moving picture rights rest exclusively with Formula One Administration Limited and that any moving picture and image originated, filmed or recorded at any Grand Prix circuit shall not be used for commercial purposes and may only be used for the private enjoyment of the person originating, filming or recording such images.

Release, Waiver And Discharge Of Liability And Indemnity Form For Children Below 7

Any person under 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised at all times by his or her parent/guardian who must also hold a valid ticket. Children below the age of seven (7) must not only hold a valid ticket, but will only be admitted if the parent/guardian signs a release, waiver and discharge of liability and indemnity form. Both child and parent/guardian must hold a valid ticket.

How Do I Get There?

As a street circuit, there will inevitably be a high volume of traffic around the Circuit Park. Please refer to your ticket for the nearest gate(s). Plan your route accordingly, allowing plenty of time to get to the Marina Bay Street Circuit.

MRT train and shuttle bus services will operate on all three days of the race weekend (15,16,17 September 2017). However, please note that public buses servicing the vicinity of the Circuit Park may be disrupted.

A public transport guide to and from the Circuit Park will be made available at www.singaporegp.sg on Monday, 4 Sep 2017.

Parking

Given the increased volume of traffic around the Circuit Park, it is highly recommended that you take public transport. If you decide to drive, please note that there is limited parking around the Circuit Park due to road closures.

Wheelchair Accessible Platforms

Turn 1 (Zone 1)

The Turn 1 wheelchair accessible platform is located within Zone 1 and can be accessed from Nicoll Highway MRT via Gate 1.

Empress Place (Zone 4)

The Empress Place wheelchair accessible platform can be accessed from Raffles Place MRT via Gate 4.

Whilst many areas within the Circuit Park are accessible, the condition of several walkways as well as the relative positions of gates, overpasses and underpasses may restrict wheelchair access to various parts of the Circuit Park.

To move from Zone 1 to Zone 4, patrons in wheelchairs are advised to exit Zone 1 through Gate 1 and re-enter the Circuit Park through Gate 4 (beside Victoria Concert Hall) or Gate 5 (beside One Fullerton)

Getting Around The Circuit

Maps are available at strategic locations within the Circuit Park.

You can also obtain a copy of the race guide at all gates and Information Booths located within the Circuit Park.
