FIA BEST TEAM OF OFFICIALS OF THE 2018 SEASON



The Formula 1 Singapore Grand Prix's team of volunteer marshals was named FIA's Best Team of Officials of the 2018 Season for their exceptional work in keeping the night race running safely and smoothly.

Given out annually as part of the FIA Volunteers & Officials Awards to recognise the best teams of motorsport officials, teams from all over the world are assessed based on their leadership competence, performance and group dynamics.

Despite being a relatively young team with limited experience in motorsport events, the Singapore team of volunteer officials are extremely dedicated and have consistently contributed to the success of the F1 night race. Comprising 900 officials, the team regularly has a high retention rate – in 2018, 93 percent of officials had volunteered from the year before.

Fun Facts:

- The team has an exceptionally high percentage of female volunteers covering almost all available roles, including Crane Operators, Starters, Chief of Communications, Fire Marshals, doctors as well as Pit and Grid Marshals.
- The trophy shares the same design as the those given to the second and third placed drivers in the FIA Formula One World Drivers' Championship. This means that Ferrari's Sebastian Vettel and Kimi Raikkonen took home similarly designed trophies last year.
