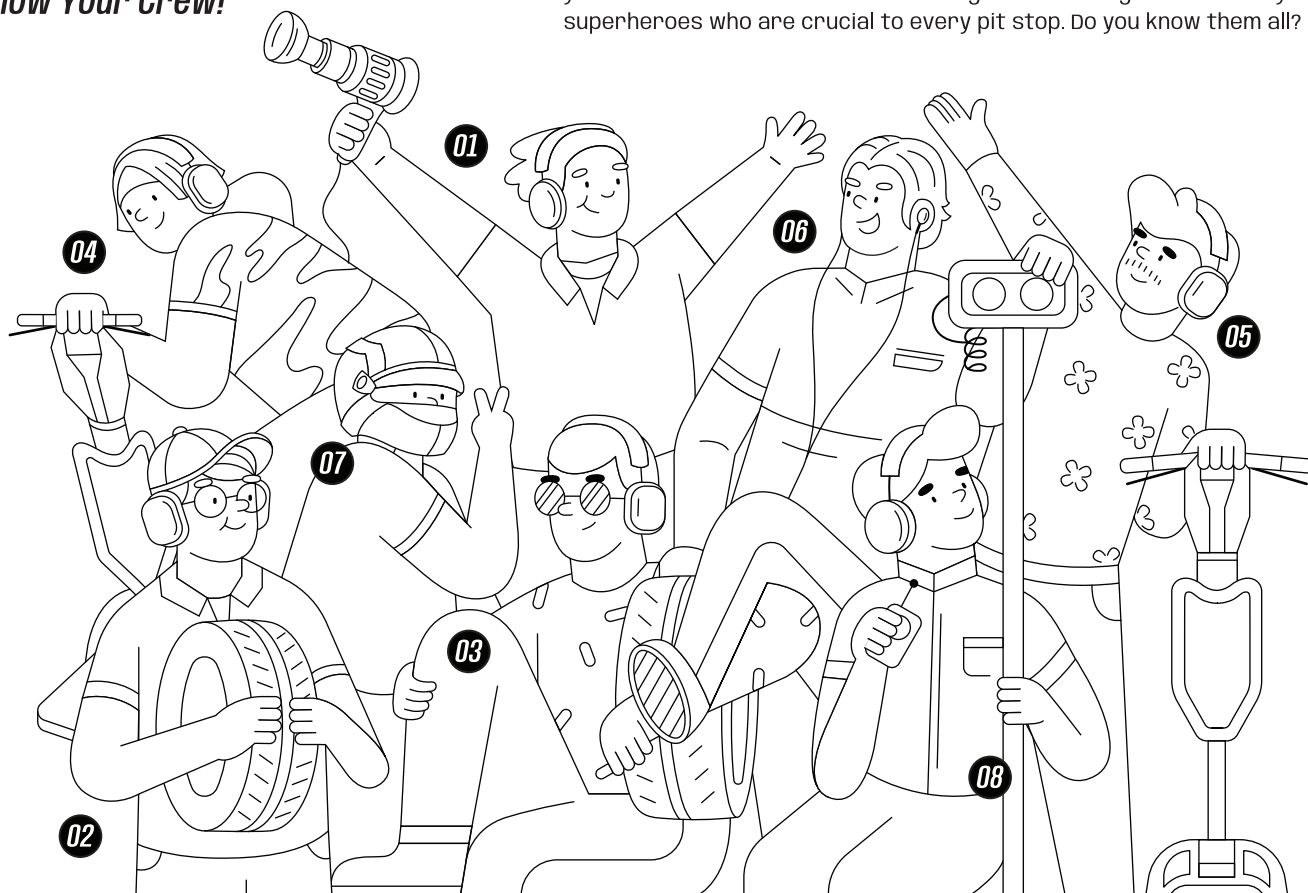

Pit Stop 1:
Know Your Crew!

A top-notch crew is the secret formula to winning a race. Whip out your markers to colour the crew and get to know eight of the many superheroes who are crucial to every pit stop. Do you know them all?



- 01 Tyre Gunner**
Handles the wheel gun to remove and fit the wheel nut with great speed
- 02 Tyre Off**
Uses incredible strength to remove and replace a heavy tyre in a flash
- 03 Tyre On**
Known for their swift accuracy to fit new tyres onto a car in milliseconds
- 04 Front Jack**
Wields the special weapon that lifts the car from the front in a pit stop

- 05 Rear Jack**
Has similar powers as the front jack, in charge of lifting the car from behind
- 06 Side Jack**
Known as the 'steadier' jack, ensuring that the car is stable when in the air
- 07 Front Wing Flap Adjust**
Handles engineering powers to give cars the wings they need to win
- 08 Pit Stop Controller**
Gives the signal when the car is safe and ready to get back on track

In Singapore's heat and humidity, drivers can lose

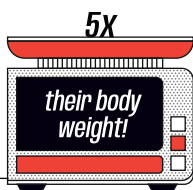

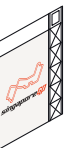
