
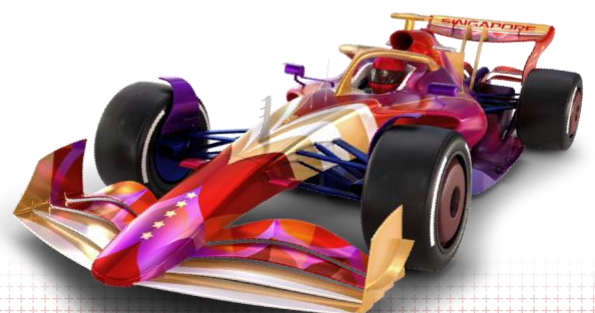

	<p>The Beginner's Guide to Singapore GP</p> <p>The Beginner's Guide to Singapore GP will feature talks by personnel who are involved in different aspects of the race, including a Singaporean CFD Methodology engineer working with the Williams Racing F1 team, an Operations representative from Singapore GP, and a volunteer race marshal. Both sessions are free-of-charge and will be held at 3.00pm on 17th June at Toa Payoh Public Library and 24th June at Bedok Public Library. 	<p>Behind-The-Scenes Tours</p> <p>Visitors on the tours will get to view restricted areas of the Marina Bay Street Circuit, including the Race Control Room, Formula 1 garages, Media Centre, winners' podium as well as some of the latest sustainability innovations in place for the event. The one-hour tour will be held on 19th and 20th August. Tickets for the tours are available for free via balloting.
